The Talent Hunt provides exposure, encouragement, and financial assistance to talented high school students in grades 9 through 12. Students compete for scholarships and the opportunity to showcase their talent to a distinguished group of judges. Local, state, and district Talent Hunt programs are competitive. The international program is a demonstration of first-place winners from around the world.



The mission of the Talent Hunt is to identify the talented and motivated youth of our communities and to provide an appropriate competitive forum for the display of their talents in the areas of Music: Vocal and instrumental; classical, semi-classical, gospel and jazz; Interpretive Movement to Music: ballet, modern dance and tap; Speech: Poetry, orations, monologues, etc. and Art: Visual, sculptures and photography. The Talent Hunt provides exposure, encouragement and financial assistance to talented young people participating in the performing arts. Winners are given recognition awards and may receive college scholarships.
